





Beaver Meadow Foxhounds 2016 Summer Rides

Nessa-Lee Cross-Country Field Hunter Course and Hunter Pace / Trail Ride

2949 Challice Line, Millbrook, ON

Sunday, May 8th

NEW THIS YEAR Participants may ride a separate, inviting cross-country course (under 2km) of ~10 inviting, field-hunt jumps (coops, split rails, log piles) at three levels of difficulty. It's non-competitive; this is a good schooling opportunity for eventers and field hunters. (Max two refusals at one obstacle). The course will be open from 8-10AM, start times will be assigned, early paid entrants may indicate a preferred start time. Course can be walked from 2-6 PM on Sat. May 7th.

First Flight – up to 3'3" (splash-through water)

Second Flight – up to 2'6" (walk-through water)

Third Flight – up to 18" (Walk over bridge, Western riders may enter)

The hunter pace/trail ride will starting at 10AM and pass through the Ganaraska East

Forest. English and Western riders are welcome, a riding helmet is required for any phase of this event including the field hunter course. Jumps will be available, as for year. The ride will start at 10AM (long ride ~18km, short ride, ~8km). Go with a group of friends if you wish. Maps, huntsman's hints and nature notes will be provided. A hearty, hot lunch will be served in Nessa-Lee's Sun Room. Placings will be determined on times that are closest to the ideal.

Entry fees: On or before May 1st \$50 incl. lunch (BMFH members \$40, Juniors \$20)

Late entry fee for all comers (if places available) \$60, extra lunches \$10

Cross-Country Field Hunter Course is extra \$15, \$10 for juniors (18 and under)
